How to find us

From M62 / A63

From where the M62 ends, continue on the A63 past the Melton major traffic lights (please be aware of new speed restrictions). You should now be able to see the River Humber, Makro and B& Q on your right. On approaching the flyover (not over) take the first turn off to the left signposted for Hull Royal Infirmary and local traffic. At the first roundabout go straight on down Rawlings Way. At the first set of major traffic lights (new) turn right onto Anlaby Road (A1105), past the Hull Royal Infirmary which is on the left. Continue on to the second set of major traffic lights and turn right onto Icehouse Road, carry on down onto Walker street past the Goodwin Club on the left hand side and carry on past the shops. The Octagon is on the right hand side, with parking to the rear.

Please leave your car registration number at the reception desk and sign in.

From Beverley Road A1079

Continue along Beverley Road (A1079) driving straight on through all the traffic lights for approximately 3 ½ miles where you will arrive at a major road junction controlled by traffic lights. Stay in the central lane. The Hull Daily Mail building should be on your right. Drive straight on across the lights onto Ferensway (A1079) and continue forward until you see the Railway and Bus Station and the Quality Royal Hotel on your right. At the next main junction with traffic lights turn right onto Anlaby Road (A1105). At the next major set of traffic lights turn left onto Icehouse Road. Carry straight on past the Goodwin Club on your left hand side and past the shops. The Octagon is situated on the left hand side with parking to the rear.

Arriving by Train

From the main concourse take the exit to the right. Turn right onto the railway car park and left again where you will see some gates in an alley between the buildings. You should now be on Anlaby Road. Use the road crossing and continue walking on until you see the old Nettos building. Turn left onto Pease Street and continue onto the bottom. At the T-junction turn right onto St Lukes Street and left again at the next T-junction onto Icehouse Road. The Goodwin Centre is immediately to your right, please call into the Goodwin Centre and the Receptionist will be more than happy to direct you over to The Octagon.

The Goodwin Centre is approximately 5 minutes walk from the train and bus station and 10 minutes from the town centre.
